ADBSS Annual Sheep Hunters' Clinic

To be held via live stream on October 3, 2020
8:00 am Arizona Time

The ADBSS is committed to helping all 2020 sheep hunters have a safe, enjoyable hunt. Unfortunately, we have found it necessary to cancel our annual in-person Sheep Hunters' Clinic, but will live stream the event on October 3, 2020. There is no charge for the clinic, which will begin at 8:00 am and last until approximately 11:30. The clinic is specifically designed for those who have drawn a sheep permit for 2020 and any friends, family members and/or outfitters who will be helping on the hunt.

Some of the topics to be covered include bighorn sheep hunting techniques, how to identify a trophy ram, gear and equipment for your hunt, optics, taxidermy and field care of your ram, photographing the hunt, and hunter ethics. You will be able to ask questions of the speakers via the chat feature, or via email during the clinic.

In addition to the presentations, we have asked representatives from all of the Arizona Game and Fish Department regions, the KOFA and Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuges, the Lake Mead National Recreation Area, and the Bureau of Land Management to provide information for clinic attendees about specific hunt units and regions.

The Society also offers material to help you learn more about sheep hunting. The ADBSS's *A Guide to Hunting the Arizona Bighorn Sheep* booklet, a guide to scoring and judging bighorn rams, contact information for all the Arizona land management agencies, and a clinic agenda will be posted on the ADBSS website at www.adbss.org so that you can follow the speakers and gain as much knowledge as possible.
