Project Description:

From Phoenix: Proceed north in the I-17 to Flagstaff. Go east on I-40 to the 89A Page exit, proceed north on 89A to Fredonia. Turn left on Highway 389 (Pratt Street) and proceed approximately 8.3 miles and turn left on the Mount Trumbull Rd. Go approximately 26.1 miles then turn left on road 1058 (Robertson Road). Go 9.8 miles on the 1058 road and turn left on road 1127 (Pine Nut Road) for approximately 3.2 miles and turn right on two track road following sign. Stay on road for .89 miles to camp.

Special Advisories:

The project will consist of removing the failing existing system and replacing it with approximately 10,000 gallon capacity tanks, constructing a 24'x 96' apron and drinker and pipe-rail fence.

SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED

1. Road to the camp may have sandy conditions, so motor homes and trucks pulling trailers may have to stop short of the campsite.
2. Please bring your own water.
3. Funded by the Bighorn Sheep Tag Fund, ADBSS, federal aid to the Arizona Game and Fish Department, and the Bureau of Land Management.
4. Please follow the map and do not drive off existing roads.
5. Please do not destroy existing vegetation.
6. Campsites should not be located more than 50 feet from existing two track roads and around the camp area.
7. Fire rings and vehicle tracks leading to the camps should be raked out when leaving the project.

General Advisories:

This is a remote high desert area and the possibilities of life threatening injuries exist. Volunteers should be in good physical condition and comfortable hiking and working in rugged terrain. Volunteers should bring and wear protective clothing. A sack lunch, rain gear, sun-screen, and water (enough for the whole day) to the project site. Project site is unsafe for young children due to the steep terrain and the use of construction equipment. Parents or guardians must maintain direct control and supervision of any minors on the project site at all times. Projects will take place regardless of local weather conditions.
